Thank you for your letter of 10 July which was discussed by the HRA Committee on Tuesday evening.

The HRA Committee welcomed the proposed measures you outlined, particularly the Safer Routes to School programme, and were particularly pleased at the emphasis on improved safety as the primary consideration going forward. Your confirmation of remaining decisions from the previous trial, following the feedback the Council had received, was also appreciated and will be communicated to HRA members.

On the Portswood Project website pages, it is noted that reference is made to the implementation of Hill Lane Safety Measures and that a post-scheme review on the effectiveness of the speed cushions for compliance with the speed limit had been carried out. Such a review on the Brookvale Road, Russell Place and Abbots Way proposed speed calming restrictions would be supported.

We would like to thank you for communicating clearly. Your refreshing approach and direct letters to HRA Officers was valued.

HRA will be happy to work with the Council on future ideas for improving Portswood Broadway. We agree with the priorities and aims described in your letter.

We look forward to working together later in the year.
